From the Seneschal

From the meanderings of a contemplative Seneschal,

This of course took some cautionary skills of observance, yet I was distracted by thoughts of Grand Outlandish and even farther out Lonely Mountain. I thought of service, what kind of Guardsman to the Barony was I going to be. What was I going to set up and who was I going to party with. I was young in the tribe and was still star struck with Kings, Nobels, and Peers. I was still trying to unravel the SCA and its peoples figuring out what I was committing too.

I challenge myself and my Outlands to less roasting and more boasting of the chosen tribe we belong to.


