Exchequer's Report

Dear Reader,

From the office of the baronial exchequer, I pen this report.

Financially, the barony is stable, although fluctuating to the downside at the moment.

We have several investments in place in the form of events that are happening throughout the year.

I've just spent my morning gathering documents, reimbursement request forms, and invoices. The ink is still wet on a half dozen checks that are going out to make sure we have a grand Grand Outlandish!

Site deposits are going out for Midwinter and The Guild Presents A Sworded Knocks (Working Title)

When all is said and done, we're sitting at just above \$18,000 in liquid assets. A full reckoning of our non-cash assets remains unclear, but the quartermaster and I are working diligently on the matter.

We have invested in a new baronial Marquee, which will serve us for years to come. The financial committee agreed that this was a wise investment, given the rising costs and increasing demand for the sole period tentmaker in the U.S. Our other pavilions are still in workable condition, but it would be nice to have a brand new one that will surely last us.

The barony has banded to get a secure spot for our trailers at our keep and to place those trailers on those secure spots.

There was a break-in at our keep this quarter, but nothing was taken. It was a smash and grab operation that could have happened at any secure facility. As such, the seneschalate decided to retain the services of Extra Space Storage. We will not be moving our keep at this time.

Tribes and Meaning

Submitted by: Noble Cortland d'Erlon, I've come into an office that demands a great deal of time and energy - Baronial Exchequer. To surmount this challenge, I must uncover a purpose for doing so. For whom am I doing this and why? I am blessed to have found a tribe within the barony and their companionship bestows meaning on my endeavors. Some concepts and constructs are lost on my neurodivergent mind. Words like "fun" and "play" have always rung like a language I cannot learn. I've seen the frustration on people's faces when they ask, "Did you have fun?" and I don't understand the question. I could toss an easy "yes" or "no," but both seem disingenuous. I can neither agree nor disagree with a statement I don't comprehend.

I spent years trying to ingratiate myself with a clan to which I tangentially relate. They are good people with kind hearts and a lust for brotherhood. Though they never made me feel unwelcome, I never felt at home. We shared a love of hiţng each other with sticks, but our values were unmatched. We spoke different languages.

At long last, through deliberate openness and spectacular serendipity, a cascade of associations fell upon me. It wasn't long with these people before I felt the warmth of their presence. Our perspectives resonated. To them, divergence and diversity was more than accepted – it was celebrated. Our weirds don't always match, but they don't conflict.

They don't ask me if I had fun. They understand the duress it causes me. They ask me if I enjoyed myself, or if I did as I intended to do. I understand that is the definition of fun, but I can't bring the two together in my mind. And they understand that.

For personal reasons which I'm open about – but not publish-in-the-newsletter open about – I had to take a hiatus from SCA activities. The hiatus led to shame over missing events. The shame prolonged hiatus. You can imagine where this is going.

Perhaps I was projecting when I returned and believed my former clan felt betrayed by my extended absence. Had I broken trust? Had I betrayed some code that I wasn't aware of? I was met with cautious attempts at "Where have you been?" Questions my shame would not allow me to answer. Questions whose answers I wasn't sure would be received. That clan does not accept weakness or frailty. They do not know "can't." If you wanted to be here, you would have. Again,

these are good people. This is their culture and in the name of diversity, it must be allowed – and celebrated. My tribe welcomed me with celebration and embrace. It didn't matter where I had or hadn't been. All that mattered is that I had returned.

I'm still not sure what fun is, but now that I have a place where I feel at home, I am learning to play. And as I narrow my eyes at this mountainous duty before me, I know that the barony means something to people who mean something to me – and that's meaningful.
